### Opening draws

#### UAlbany's America East Tournament history

- The Great Danes have advanced to the America East championship game for the eighth consecutive season. This is UAlbany's seventh straight meeting with Stony Brook in the title game.
- UAlbany last won the league tournament in 2012, when it defeated Stony Brook, 9-7.
- UAlbany has advanced to the NCAA Tournament four times, including last season, when it earned an at-large berth as the America East runner-up.

#### A rematch with Stony Brook

- Stony Brook, the nation's No. 1-ranked team all season, won the regular-season meeting, 21-8, in Albany.
- Emma Powlin scored five times in the regular-season meeting. Sam Tortora had six points (one goal, five assists).
- Kyle Ohlmiller and Courtney Murphy scored six goals apiece for the Seawolves.

# INTERIM HEAD COACH JESSICA DAVOS

Jessica Davos, in her eighth season with UAlbany, was named Interim Head Coach in January 2018. She previously had spent two years as Associated Head Coach after six years as the team's first assistant.

In 2017, with Davos in her first season as the team's associate head coach, the Great Danes earned a top-10 victory over Cornell and the program's second at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament, finishing 12-6 overall with a berth in the America East title game. UAlbany's defensive team captains, Sierra McIver and Andrea Flood, each earned America East All-Conference honors while goalkeeper Erin Leghart was placed on the league's all-rookie team.

In 2016, Davos's defense ranked fifth in Division I in scoring defense, allowing 6.94 goals per game and allowing double digit goals in just four of UAlbany's 17 games. Christine Johnson earned America East Co-Defensive Player of the Year, joining goalkeeper Courtney Henderson and defender Sierra McIver as all-conference players. UAlbany's defense helped the Great Danes earn its seventh consecutive double digit win season, going 11-6 and reaching the America East title game.

Under Davos's guidance, the Danes were top-five in scoring defense for the third-straight year in 2015 with a 14-5 overall record. UAlbany allowed just 6.68 goals per game with an experienced defense, anchored by America East First Team pick Erin Monna and two-time All-Conference selection Michelle Primomo. Junior goalkeeper Courtney Henderson ranked third nationally in goals against average on her way to league First Team honors.

For the fifth-straight year, Davos boasted a back line that ranked top-20 in scoring defense, and the second straight year the Great Danes have ranked top-five. Behind four-year goalie Anna Berman, UAlbany allowed just 6.82 goals per game in 17 games. Davos led draw control specialist Kathleen Lennon to rank first on the team in draw controls and ground balls again in 2014, earning Lennon IWLCA All-America honors plus her second straight IWLCA All-Region team selection. Berman was also named to the America East All-Conference Second Team.

UAlbany ranked fifth in the nation in scoring defense in 2013, allowing 131 goals (7.71 per game) in 17 games. The Great Danes averaged 7.59 caused turnovers per game. 2013 marked the third consecutive year that UAlbany has ranked in the top-20 nationally in scoring defense.

Davos led the Great Danes to their second consecutive America East title in 2012. Goalie Anna Berman ranked 18th in the national in goals against average (9.51).

In 2011, Davos helped the Great Danes capture their first America East Conference championship and advance to



the NCAA Tournament's quarterfinal round. The Great Danes were ranked for 15 weeks in the 2011 season, winning 18 straight games. UAlbany had the second-best scoring defense in the nation, allowing just 7.32 goals per game.

Davos previously spent two seasons as a Harvard University assistant. At Harvard, Davos worked for Lisa Miller, her college head coach at Syracuse University. The Crimson posted their best Ivy League record in four years and had three all-league players in 2010. Prior to that position, Davos served as the head coach at Bryant University for one season. She guided the Bulldogs to a 10-8 record in the program's final NCAA Division II campaign. Bryant also finished third in the Northeast-10 Conference with a league mark of 7-3 and three players earned all-conference recognition.

In 2007, Davos was the head coach at Bentley College, a Division II program that also competed in the Northeast-10 Conference. She led the Falcons to their best season in seven years with an 11-6 record, improving the team's win total by four from the previous season. Bentley placed third in the league standings and reached the conference postseason tournament championship game. Four Falcons received all-conference honors and one was chosen to the IWLCA All-America second team.

A native of Albany, N.Y. and a graduate of Albany Academy, Davos also worked at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute as both an assistant women's soccer and women's lacrosse coach.

Davos (formerly DeRosa) earned four varsity lacrosse letters at Syracuse, where she received an undergraduate degree in English and textual studies. The Orange had a combined 44-19 record during her career, plus qualified for three NCAA Division I Tournaments and won the 1999 ECAC championship. She was selected to the 2002 Big East Conference Academic All-Star squad.

At Albany Academy, Davos was named to the 1998 U.S. Lacrosse All-America Team and was chosen CDWLL Player of the Year. She earned consensus All-Area honors in soccer and lacrosse. Davos and her husband, Jim, have two daughters, Alexa and Ashley.

# NOTES

## ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC), and football, a Division I FCS program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup for five consecutive years and six times overall.

UAlbany has won 103 conference championships and has made 48 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. UAlbany won its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, with softball taking the America East Tournament. Going into the 2017-18 school year, UAlbany has won 93 America East Tournament championships, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football and one MAAC title in women's golf.

During the 2016-17 school year, UAlbany earned an America East-record nine championships: men's and women's soccer; women's basketball; men's and women's indoor track and field; men's lacrosse and softball. Men's soccer and men's lacrosse each won NCAA Tournament games to lead UAlbany to finish No. 40 nationally in the 2016-17 Capital One Cup. Women's basketball won a conference record sixth consecutive America East Tournament, the longest such streak for any basketball team in the league.

Throughout its Division I history, UAlbany has had 14 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft and nine players drafted by Major League Baseball. Fourteen football players have inked NFL contracts.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### **UAlbany returns to America East championship game**

- For the seventh straight season, the America East title game will match UAlbany against Stony Brook.
- The Seawolves lead the all-time series, 16-7, and have won the past 11 meetings between the teams.
- Stony Brook has beaten UAlbany in the past five league championship games, with the Great Danes' last win coming in 2012, when they won, 9-7.
- The past two title games have been decided by just three goals combined. Stony Brook won, 14-12, last season and 10-9 the year before.
- UAlbany advanced to the championship game with a 16-10 victory over Binghamton in the semifinals. Sam Tortora (three goals, four assists) led the Great Danes with seven points. Kyla Zapolski scored five goals. Emma Powlin and Kendra Harbinger each had a hat trick.

### **Harbinger wins America East Rookie of the Year**

- Kendra Harbinger was named the America East Rookie of the Year at the league's annual awards banquet this past Thursday. The seven-time America East Rookie of the Week honoree is the Great Danes' leader in shots on goal (80), free-position goals (15) and draw controls (53). Her 42 goals are second most on the team.
- Harbinger's nine-point (seven-goal, two-assist) outing in an April 4 win over Vermont set a record for most points in a game by a UAlbany freshman.
- She's scored three or more goals in eight games this season.

### **UAlbany lands 6 on All-Conference Teams, 4 on All-Academic Squad**

- Three Great Danes were named to the America East All-Conference First Team: attacker Emma Powlin, midfielder Sam Tortora and defender Jordyn Marr. Midfielder Kaylee Rickert was named to the Second Team.
- Kendra Harbinger and Kyla Zapolski were named to the All-Rookie Team.
- Erin Leghart, Jordyn Marr, Kaylee Rickert and Emma Powlin all were named to the league's All-Academic Team.

### Great Danes surge in season's second half

- After starting the season 0-7, the Great Danes have won nine of their past 10.
- UAlbany had played a challenging non-conference schedule, with games against No. 4 Syracuse and No. 17 Penn State as well as reigning Northeast Conference champion Bryant, Connecticut and Dartmouth, now ranked No. 21 in the country.
- Since the 0-7 start, UAlbany's goal differential has almost completely reversed. Over the first seven games of the season, the Great Danes were outscored 104-65; over the past 10, UAlbany is outscoring its opponents 137-90.
- Most notably, the Great Danes have allowed double-digit goals only three times during the past 10 games: in a 12-10 victory over Binghamton on March 31; in a 21-8 loss to Stony Brook in the regular-season finale; and in Friday's 16-10 victory over Binghamton in the league semifinals.

### Youth serves Great Danes

- UAlbany is one of the youngest teams in the country, with 20 of 24 players on the roster being underclassmen.
- The Great Danes' leader in assists (Sam Tortora, 32), draw controls (Kendra Harbinger, 53) and caused turnovers (Jordyn Marr, 20) are underclassmen. And in goal, sophomore Erin Leghart has started all 17 games, posting a .446 save percentage.
- UAlbany student-athletes have won eight America East Rookie of the Week awards this season — seven for Kendra Harbinger and one for Kyla Zapolski.

### Powlin stars in senior season

Emma Powlin, a senior attacker from Penfield, N.Y., has enjoyed an outstanding senior season.

- She leads the Great Danes in scoring with 60 points (46 goals, 14 assists).
- On Senior Day on April 14, Powlin scored five goals and picked up two assists to lead a 14-5 victory over UMass Lowell. But that wasn't even her best effort of the season. She had a seven-goal afternoon against Hartford on March 24, and she's had three seven-point games this season.
- Powlin, who was an America East All-Conference Second-Team member as a junior, was named an Inside Lacrosse Preseason DI Media All-America Honorable Mention before the season.

### Rickert shines at both ends of the field.

Junior midfielder Kaylee Rickert has been a leader for the Great Danes on offense, defense and in the midfield.
