TODAY'S STORYLINES

UAlbany Set for Key Road Matchup with Vermont

The University at Albany men's lacrosse team faces Vermont on the road Saturday, April 6, in a game that holds key implications for the America East standings. Faceoff is at 2:30 p.m. at Virtue Field.

UAlbany currently sits alone in first place at 3-0, with both Vermont and Stony Brook one game back. All three teams have three games remaining in league play. The Great Danes and Seawolves play in the regular-season finale April 26 at Stony Brook.

UAlbany is coming off a 14-10 home win over Hartford this past Saturday, March 30, for its third victory in four games overall. Vermont, meanwhile, was dealt its first league setback, 8-4 to UMass Lowell.

The game will be a rematch of the 2018 America East title game, won by UAlbany, 14-4, at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. The Great Danes also had beaten the Catamounts, 21-5, in Albany during the regular season and have won eight straight overall in the series, with Vermont's most recent victory coming in 2011.

Vermont is led by junior attack Ben French (24 points) and sophomore attack Liam Limoges (24 points).

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) and football, a Division I Football Championship Subdivision program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the America East's top performing athletics department, for six consecutive years and seven times overall.

UAlbany has won 110 conference championships and has made 54 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past eight years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. UAlbany has 102 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2017-2018, UAlbany earned seven conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances. Men's lacrosse, ranked No. 1 nationally for six weeks during the regular season, reached the Final Four, and men's soccer advanced to the NCAA Tournament's second round. Softball, men's and women's outdoor track, women's indoor track and golf also won league titles. In the classroom, 11 teams carried a GPA of 3.2 or higher.

In its Division I history, UAlbany has had 18 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine players drafted by Major League Baseball and 14 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions and Great Danes.

TEAM NOTES

THE SERIES WITH VERMONT

UAlbany leads the all-time series, 17-3, and has won eight straight. The Catamounts' most recent win over the Great Danes was 11-6 in Burlington on April 10, 2011. UAlbany defeated Vermont twice last season in Albany: 21-5 during the regular season and 14-4 in the America East championship game. Jakob Patterson scored 10 goals against Vermont last season, including seven in the regular-season meeting.

PATTERSON LEADS THE WAY

Junior attack Jakob Patterson has scored a goal in each of the past eight games and has a point in all nine games this season. He is UAlbany's season leader in points (43), goals (18), assists (25) and shots (64). He's No. 1 in the league in both assists per game (2.78) and points per game (4.78).

NANTICOKE HEATS UP

Tehoka Nanticoke has 17 points over his past four games, including a six-point (five-goal) effort against Hartford on March 30. The sophomore attack has a goal in all seven games in which he's played this season and has posted multiple goals five times.

JONES THRIVES IN THE FACEOFF X

Sophomore faceoff specialist Austin Jones is second in the America East with a 55.2 winning percentage, and he's been at his best over the past three weeks. Jones has won 48 of his past 74 faceoffs over the past three games — a .659 clip. He's had several dominating performances this season: an 18-for-25 day against Hartford, a 16-for-27 performance against Harvard, and a 25-of-37 effort against Cornell.

BURGMASER DOES IT ALL

Senior midfielder Jack Burgmaster has been strong at both ends of the field for the Great Danes this season. Burgmaster not only had a hat trick against Hartford on March 30, but he also picked up four ground balls. For the season, he's UAlbany's ground-ball leader with 20 and also is second on the team with nine caused turnovers.

BALANCED ATTACK

Through nine games, UAlbany has had six different players lead or tie for the lead forgoals in a game. Six different players also have had at least a share of the assists lead for a game.

WE'RE NO. 1

UAlbany leads the America East in four statistical categories: assists per game (7.56), clearing percentage (.881), points per game (19.33) and scoring offense (11.78). The Great Danes are second in faceoff percentage (.488), saves per game (13.33) and shot percentage (.296).

THE 100-POINT CLUB

Jakob Patterson, Sean Eccles and Tehoka Nanticoke each have reached the 100-career point milestone this season. Patterson hit the mark March 16 against UMass Lowell, while Eccles and Nanticoke got their 100th points against Harvard on March 27.

AMERICA EAST SUCCESS

UAlbany is looking for its 10th conference championship this season. The Great Danes have won three of the past four titles, including the past two. UAlbany has a 29-1 regular-season record in the league dating back to the 2013 season, and the Great Danes haven't lost a regular-season home game to an America East team since April 28, 2012 (Stony Brook, 12-11).

SIEKIERSKI'S SOLID IN THE NET

Junior goalkeeper Nate Siekierski is averaging an America East-best 13.75 saves per game through his first eight collegiate starts. He's had three games this season with 16 or more saves, including a career-high 17 in his first career start. And he's had 43 over his past three outings, with 17 against Binghamton, 16 at Harvard and 10 against Hartford. Earlier this season he had a 14-save performance at Drexel, including a stop with 10 seconds to play that preserved the victory.

The Parker, Colo., native had made 13 appearances over his first two seasons, posting a 12.11 goals-against average and .476 save percentage. He also has big-game experience, having played almost 25 minutes in the 2018 national semifinals against Yale. He also made five saves over 31 minutes against Maryland in the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

YUNKER PICKS UP FIRST HAT TRICK

Freshman attacker Corey Yunker got his first career hat trick with a three-goal performance against Binghamton. He now has four goals on the season after also having scored against Drexel in his first career start.

Yunker is one of three UAlbany freshmen who have made their debuts this season: Teioshontathe McComber, who had an assist against Syracuse, and Tanner Hay also have played.

LAFFIN'S CAREER DAY

Junior attack Mitch Laffin had a career day against UMass Lowell, leading the Great Danes with seven goals — the most scored by a Great Danes player this season.

GREAT DANES IN THE PLL

UAlbany men's lacrosse alumni will be well-represented in the Premier Lacrosse League, which debuts with its inaugural season this coming June.

Eight former Great Danes, including six of whom will play on the same squad, are signed to play in the six-team league when it opens June 1.

Connor Fields, Miles Thompson, Joe Resetarits, Kyle McClancy, Troy Reh and Blaze Riorden all will play for Chaos LC, while Ty Thompson and Brett Queener are on the Chrome LC roster.

Together, they represent some of the top players in UAlbany history. Miles Thompson was a co-Tewaaraton Trophy recipient with his brother, Lyle, in 2014. He and Resetarits both were USILA First-Team All-Americans, while Fields and Riorden both were Third-Team All-Americans.

Fields, McClancy and Reh are reunited after having last played together on the 2018 UAlbany team that reached the NCAA Championship weekend for the First Time.

NANTICOKE NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

Tehoka Nanticoke has been named to the Watch List for the Tewaaraton Trophy, the most prestigious award in college lacrosse.

Nanticoke was among the 50 men's and 50 women's student-athletes across all divisions of NCAA lacrosse who were named to the list.

The field will be narrowed to 25 candidates on April 25 and then to five finalists on May 9. The finalists will be invited to attend the Tewaaraton Award Ceremony in Washington, D.C., on May 30.

ECCLES SELECTED IN MLL DRAFT

Sean Eccles was selected No. 11 overall in the Major League Lacrosse Collegiate Draft, held Saturday, March 9, in Charlotte, N.C.

ECCLES, NANTICOKE EARN PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Two UAlbany players were honored by Inside Lacrosse as Preseason Media DI All-Americans. Sophomore attack Tehoka Nanticoke was named to the All-America Third Team, and senior midfielder Sean Eccles was among the Honorable Mentions.

Nanticoke was named both a USILA and Inside Lacrosse All-American after a sensational first season that saw him total 50 goals and 82 points in leading the Great Danes to the NCAA Championship Weekend. The native of Six Nations, Ontario, also earned the America East Rookie of the Year award.

Eccles started all 19 games in the midfield as a sophomore, totaling 33 goals and 47 points. He had 10 multi-goal games on his way to earning a spot on the America East All-Conference Second Team.

HOMECOMING FOR MALONEY, RUSSELL

UAlbany welcomed back John Maloney as an Assistant Coach and Connor Russell as a Volunteer Assistant this coming season.

Maloney, a 2016 graduate with a degree in Human Biology, was a two-time All-America East midfielder and senior captain for the Great Danes. He finished his collegiate career with 76 goals, 45 assists and 127 ground balls before playing one season of Major League Lacrosse with the Chesapeake Bayhawks, totaling 11 points (four goals, seven assists) in 10 games. A native of Victor, N.Y., Maloney spent one season as an assistant coach at Skidmore College in 2016-17 and another at St. John Fisher this past year.

Russell graduated from UAlbany in 2017 with a degree in Sociology and then spent a season as Associate Head Coach at SUNY Geneseo. While at UAlbany, he was an undergraduate assistant coach responsible for developing strategies for the team's face-off unit and developing face-off athletes.

HONORING THE THOMPSONS

Lyle and Miles Thompson, two of the most decorated men's lacrosse players in University at Albany history, are honored in the "People of New York" exhibit that opened Thursday, Feb. 14, in the State Capitol building.

The exhibit, whose opening was announced by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, "features the people of New York - past and present - and their firsthand accounts of perseverance and migration."

"The First Peoples" portion of the exhibit includes life-size cutouts of the Thompson brothers, and accompanying text details their achievements for UAlbany. In the images, they're wearing uniforms of the Georgia Swarm, the National Lacrosse League franchise for which they now play.

Born in Onondaga Nation, near Syracuse, N.Y., Lyle and Miles became two of the most celebrated lacrosse players in the world while at UAlbany. Lyle was the first male recipient of the Tewaaraton Award in consecutive seasons, and he set new NCAA Division I records for career points (400) and assists (225). As a senior at UAlbany, Miles was the co-recipient of the Tewaaraton Award with his brother and set a NCAA Division I record for most single season goals (82).

They both were drafted by the Swarm, Miles as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2014 NLL Draft and Lyle as the No. 1 overall pick in the 2015 NLL Draft. In 2017, the tandem was instrumental in the Swarm

winning its first world championship.

The NLL is the largest professional indoor lacrosse league in North America, with seven teams in the United States and four in Canada. UAlbany has been well-represented in the league. At least one former Great Dane has been chosen in the league's draft every year since 2012.

2018 IN REVIEW

The University at Albany men's lacrosse team's historic season culminated with the program's first appearance in the Final Four. It was, without question, one of the most storied campaigns in Great Danes history. UAlbany began with a 15-3 win at Syracuse, a victory that would help vault the Great Danes to the No. 1 ranking in both national polls. In fact, men's lacrosse became the first SUNY team to be ranked No. 1 in a Division I sport. That set up a nationally televised No. 1 versus No. 2 matchup with Maryland on March 10 – a game UAlbany stormed back to win, 11-10, on the road. The Great Danes spent five weeks as the country's No. 1 team on their way to a second straight America East championship. In the NCAA Tournament, UAlbany defeated Richmond in front of 4,800 fans at Casey Stadium and then beat Denver on Long Island to reach the national semifinals for the first time. The Great Danes picked up many individual accolades along the way, sweeping the major America East Awards and having 11 all-conference players, including eight on the First Team. UAlbany finished 16-3 overall, a record that included a 10-0 mark at Casey Stadium.

University at Albany Head Coach Scott Marr

19th Year at UAlbany

2002, 2007, 2013, 2014, 2016 and 2018 America East Coach of the Year



Scott Marr is in his 19th season as UAlbany's head coach. The only coach hired in the Division I era at the University at Albany, Marr, a six-time America East Coach of the Year, has coached the Great Danes to nine America East Tournament titles, 10 appearances in the NCAA Tournament and six NCAA Tournament victories. He has a 179-114 career record at UAlbany and has coached Tewaaron winners in 2014 and 2015, 34 All-Americans, six Tewaaron finalists, two Lt. Raymond J. Enners Award winners for Most Outstanding DI Player, three Lt. Col. J.L. Turnbull Award winners for the best Attackman in the nation, 10 America East Players of the Year and 113 all-conference players.

The program enjoyed its best season in 2018, earning a No. 1 national ranking in both polls during the regular season for the first time and reaching the national semifinals. After winning their ninth America East championship, UAlbany defeated Richmond and Denver in the NCAA Tournament to reach Championship Weekend. During the regular season, the Great Danes posted wins over ranked opponents Syracuse, Maryland, Vermont and Harvard. UAlbany dominated the America East's postseason awards, sweeping all four major awards and having 11 players named to All-Conference teams. Connor Fields was honored as the America East Offensive Player of the Year, TD Ierlan was selected as the AE Defensive Player of the Year, Tehoka Nanticoke was honored as the AE Rookie of the Year and Marr was chosen as the AE Coach of the Year.

As an assistant on Dick Edell's Maryland staff for six years, Marr served as both assistant coach and offensive coordinator. Maryland made five NCAA Tournament appearances during that period and was the Division I national runner-up in 1995, 1997 and 1998. The Terrapins shattered the school's single-season scoring record with 236 goals when the program captured the '98 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season and tournament titles. Maryland's attack averaged 12.5 goals under Marr's direction from 1995-2000. All-Americans Matt Hahn and Andrew Whipple became two of the most storied scorers in school history.

Marr served as one of three assistants for the 2006 U.S. Men's Lacrosse Team that won the silver medal. Syracuse's John Desko was the U.S. team's head coach. The 2006 International Lacrosse Federation World Championship was held in London, Ontario from July 13-22.

Marr began his coaching career as the University of Delaware's offensive coordinator, where he worked with the school's all-time leading scorer Anthony DiMarzo. From 1992-94, the Blue Hens captured three consecutive North Atlantic Conference championships and earned a top-20 national ranking in each season. Marr was also an assistant on the United States team that won the 1999 World Cup.

As a collegiate player at Johns Hopkins University, Marr was an attackman on the 1987 national championship squad and the '89 national runner-up team. The Blue Jays garnered four straight NCAA berths during his career. He received a B.S. in social and behavioral sciences in 1991.

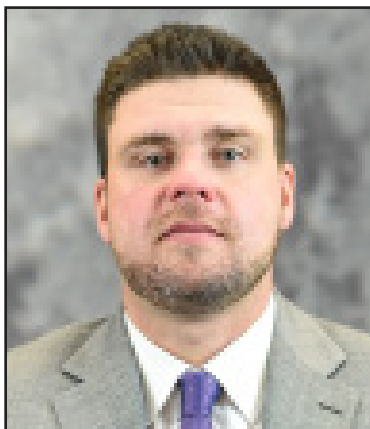
