



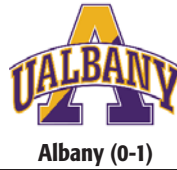

BULLDOGS HEAD TO ALBANY TO MEET GREAT DANES

- The Bryant University football team will play its second-straight game against a member of the CAA when it travels to Albany on Saturday night.
- This will be Bryant's first trip to New York's capital city since 2011.

OPENING DRIVE: BULLDOGS FALL AT STONY BROOK

- Bryant dropped its season opener at Stony Brook last Thursday, 35-10.
- The Bulldogs trailed 14-3 at the half but the Seawolves scored on three of their first four possessions of the second half.
- Luke Samperi hit a career-high 49-yard field goal and Daniel Adeboboye scored on a one-yard run to provide the Bryant scoring.
- Robert Brown led all players with nine tackles.

BRYANT AGAINST THE CAA

- Saturday will be Bryant's 18th game against a current member of the CAA.
- Bryant is 4-13 in those games.
- Those four wins have come against Albany (2), Stony Brook (1) and Maine (1).

BRYANT FOOTBALL TURNS 21

- Bryant begins its 21st season of varsity football in 2019.
- The Bryant football program was formed in 1998 and played its first varsity season in 1999.
- Bryant has won 113 games and has made a pair of DII NCAA appearances in the previous 20 seasons.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

- The Bulldogs were picked to finish fifth in the eight-team NEC this year.
- Bryant went 2-4 in league play last season.
- Vinny Nisivocchia and Tomas Wright represented Bryant on the 27-man preseason team.

THE SERIES WITH ALBANY

- Bryant and Albany will be meeting for the fifth time in program history.
- The Bulldogs and Great Danes last met in 2012, Albany's last season as an NEC member.
- Bryant is 1-1 in games at Albany, earning a 31-17 victory in 2011.

A BIT ABOUT THE GREAT DANES

- Albany was picked last in the CAA preseason coaches poll. The Great Danes went 3-8 overall and 1-7 in the CAA last year.
- Jeff Undercuffler started at QB in last week's opener, going 15-for-28 for 199 yards and two TDs.
- Juwan Green posted five catches for 94 yards and two TDs.
- Eli Mencer added a special teams TD at FBS-member Central Michigan.
- AJ Mistler posted a team-high 11 tackles in the opener. That included nine solo tackles.
- Mencer finished with 2.0 TFLs, two fumble recoveries and three forced fumbles against Central Michigan.

INTERVIEW POLICIES

Postgame Interviews: Bryant University locker rooms are closed to all media. A 10-minute cooling off period will be strictly enforced, after which the Bryant head coach and requested players will be made available to the media. Postgame interviews will be conducted outside each team's respective locker room. Requests for visiting coaches and players should be made through the opponent's sports information contact.

Player/Coach Interview Policy: Interviews other than those immediately following a contest must be requested and arranged through a member of the Bryant University athletic communications staff. Interviews will be arranged by the athletic communication staff at a time that will not interfere with the student-athlete's academic schedule. Requests should be made at least one day in advance to allow proper notification to the player or coach. At no time will the home or cell phone number of a coach or player be released to the media. In the case of telephone interview requests, arrangements will be made for the student-athlete to contact the requesting media member.

MEDIA POLICIES

Working Press Credentials: Press and photographer media credentials will be issued to members of the working media only. Credentials for all Bryant home games can be obtained by contacting the Athletic Communications Office in writing or by telephone. Credentials will be left at will call. Press pass requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to a home contest to ensure space availability.

Press Box: Only credentialed members of the media, coaches, league officials and designated administrators will be allowed in the press box area. The Bryant Athletic Communications Office will provide a game program, current press release, pregame statistics and game notes prior to each contest. A full boxscore, play-by-play, drive chart and other applicable game material will be distributed at halftime and at the end of the game.

Media Work Room: Ample work space with power outlets, telephones and internet access will be available for media members who need to file postgame reports. For men's and women's basketball contests, the Bulldog Room, located on the second floor of the Chace Athletic Center, will serve as a media workroom and postgame interview location.

Radio: Radio stations planning to broadcast Bryant home contests must make arrangements with the Athletic Communications Office at least two weeks prior to the requested game. Telephone lines will be supplied by the university, provided the requested notice is given. All calls must be made either on a collect or calling card basis.

TWO BULLDOGS PLAY IN NFL PRESEASON GAMES

- Two Bryant alums made their NFL preseason debuts in August, Tom Kennedy and Tom Costigan.
- Kennedy signed with Detroit as a undrafted free agent and Costigan signed with the Chargers.
- Kennedy and Costigan join Jordan Harris as the only three Bulldogs to play in an NFL preseason game.

KENNEDY MAKES LIONS PRACTICE SQUAD

- Kennedy became the first Bryant alum to make an NFL practice squad when the Lions signed him on Sept. 2.

WATSON RETURNS TO ALMA MATER

- One of the first hires made by Coach Merritt was Marquise Watson, a 2017 Bryant grad.
- Watson played both linebacker and defensive tackle for the Black and Gold, graduating as the program's all-time leading tackler with 256. He now ranks second.
- He will serve as the defensive line coach as well as the defensive run game coordinator.

WRIGHT STUFF

- Senior Tomas Wright returns to anchor Bryant's defensive line after posting 12.5 sacks in 2018.
- Wright set the single-season program record last fall and is fifth among active returners in sacks from last season.
- He's one of just four players in program history to record 20+ career sacks.

MORE VINNY

- After not playing a single snap in his first two seasons, Vinny Nisivoccia has caught 79 passes for 1,072 yards and seven TDs combined in 2017 and 2018.
- Nisivoccia decided to come back for his fifth year last winter and was named a preseason All-NEC selection.
- He led Bryant with 1,353 all-purpose yards a season ago.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

- Following its win over New Haven last year, Bryant is now 17-3 all-time in home openers.
- The Bulldogs have won each of their last six and are 10-1 in home openers at the DI level.
- Bryant's Sept. 14 home opener is its latest at the DI level.

OFFENSIVE GAME NOTES

VINNY, VINNY

- Vinny Nisiovocia didn't play in a varsity contest his first two years at Bryant. He's played in all 23 since.
- Nisiovocia has caught 87 passes for 1,124 yards and seven TDs in that span.
- He led the Black and Gold with 50 catches for 691 yards and six TDs last fall.
- Nisiovocia averaged 4.5 receptions and 62.8 yards per game.
- Nisiovocia's 50 catches were the 4th-most in a single season, while his receiving yards were the eighth-most.
- He's also one of 11 receivers in school history to have 1,000 career receiving yards.

NISIOVOCIA THE RETURN MAN

- Nisiovocia also added 22 returns for 496 yards and a TD last fall.
- He's one of the top returning returners in the NEC.
- Nisiovocia posted his first kick return score in the 2018 finale at Howard.
- He returned a career-high six kicks for a career-high 117 yards at Stony Brook in week 1.

ALL PURPOSE VINNY

- Nisiovocia led the Bulldogs with 1,353 AP yards last fall, an average of 123.0 per game.
- His AP yardage was the 10th-most in a single-season in program history.
- Nisiovocia had 100+ AP yards in eight of his 11 games last fall.

YOU CAN CALL ME AL (FRED)

- Alfred Dorbor is Bryant's top returning rusher from 2018.
- He posted 390 yards and a team-leading seven TDs on 86 carries.
- Dorbor enjoyed his best game of the year at Fordham when he rushed for 116 yards and two TDs on just 11 carries.

ADEBOBOYE BACK AFTER SOLID ROOKIE YEAR

- Daniel Adeboboye is back after posting 257 rushing yards and three TDs on 52 carries as a true freshman.
- Adeboboye saved his best for last, rushing for 70 yards and a TD on nine carries in the 2018 finale at Howard.
- He rushed for 53 yards on a career-high 21 carries in week 1.

HEALTHY McCRAY READY FOR 2019

- Isaac McCray is back for his third year and looks to return healthy.
- McCray has missed 12 games due to injury, including the last four in 2018, in his career.
- He posted 164 yards and two TDs on 41 carries, averaging 4.0 yards per carry.
- McCray was a two-time NEC Rookie of the Week in 2017 and is averaging 4.7 yards per carry for his career.

HINDLE WINS STARTING JOB IN CAMP

- Chris Hindle won the starting QB job during August camp.
- Hindle made one start and appeared in five games last season for the Black and Gold.
- He finished 4-of-10 for 27 yards.
- Hindle became the first freshman to start at QB since Charlie Granatell in 2004.
- Hindle missed the final three weeks of the season after suffering an injury at Sacred Heart.
- In week 1, he completed 14-of-25 passes for 98 yards.

SUP, BRO

- Broghean McGovern returns as Bryant's most experienced QB, having started a pair of games in 2018.
- He finished the year 18-of-35 for 201 yards. McGovern caught a TD and rushed for two TDs in week 11 vs. Wagner.

RAZZLE DAZZLE

- Alex Rasmussen returns for his senior season this fall.
- He posted 22 receptions for 234 yards and a touchdown.
- Rasmussen's first-career TD proved to be the game-winner against eventual league champion Duquesne.
- He also added three catches for a career-high 65 yards vs. Marist.

ZORRILLA LOOKS TO BUILD OFF SOLID ROOKIE SEASON

- David Zorrilla's first-career catch was a 23-yard TD reception against New Haven in the first game of 2018.
- Zorrilla went on to post 16 receptions for 146 yards, finishing sixth on the team in receptions.

SAMPERI FOR THE WIN

- Luke Samperi kicked a game-winning 42-yard field goal at Fordham.
- The field goal came as time expired, making it the first walk-off win in program history.
- The field goal was also the first of Samperi's career.
- Samperi hit his second-career field goal in week 1, a career-high 49-yarder.

FREDERICK'S BIG DEBUT

- Anthony Frederick posted three catches for 51 yards in his debut in week 1.
- He posted a 34-yard reception in the fourth week.

DEFENSIVE GAME NOTES

MR. WRIGHT

- Tomas Wright is back after setting the single-season record for sacks with 12.5.
- He finished in the top 10 nationally in sacks per game and total sacks.
- Wright also posted 17.5 TFLs and added three forced fumbles.
- Wright posted at least one sack in seven of 11 games a season ago.
- He had at least a half TFL in nine of the 11 games.

WRIGHT'S BIG TWO WEEKS

- Wright enters his final season with 21.5 sacks and 27 TFLs in 34 career games.
- He is one of only four players in program history to post 20+ sacks in a career.

NEMEROWICZ BACK FOR FINAL YEAR

- Jesse Nemerowicz returns to anchor the Bryant defense in 2019.
- Nemerowicz has appeared in 28 games and has posted 233 career tackles.
- He enters the season ranked third among active FCS players with 8.29 tackles per game.

- Nemerowicz posted 91 tackles as a rookie, the most by a freshman in program history.

HEAD COACH Chris Merritt

Chris Merritt was named the fourth head coach in Bryant Football history on Dec. 20, 2018.

Merritt comes to Smithfield after spending 18 years as the head coach at Christopher Columbus High School in Miami, Florida. He posted an overall record 172-45 (.792), leading the Explorers to two state finals appearances (2014, 2018), five Regional Championships, 14 District Championships and an 80-4 record in district competition in the largest high school classification in the state of Florida. In addition, Merritt's program has produced over 100 collegiate football players in 18 seasons, including current Bryant offensive linemen Kyle Mann and Robert Perez and 2016 alum Brandon Dagnesses.

"We are very excited to welcome Chris Merritt to Bryant as our next head football coach," Smith said. "Chris is a proven winner that has developed Christopher Columbus into one of the top football programs in the state of Florida. He has won 14 district championships in 18 years, while also developing over 100 student-athletes that have gone on to play college football. His intensity and commitment to student-athlete development are the perfect fit for our Bulldog program."

"As we celebrate our 20th season of Bryant football, we are thrilled to have such a successful coach start the next phase of our football program," Machtley said. "Chris has a vast track record of ensuring that he recruits scholar-athletes who can both compete in the classroom and on the field at the highest level. His values and experience are a great fit to ensure that we

maintain our momentum of a growing national reputation."

Throughout his career at Columbus, Merritt received several recognitions for his accomplishments on the field. He was inducted into the Columbus High School Hall of Fame in 2018, named the Nike Coach of the Year in 2005, the Miami Herald Coach of the Year in 2014 and the Warren Henry South Coach of the Year in 2017.

During his time at Columbus, Merritt also worked heavily with USA Football, serving as the head coach of the Junior National Team in 2010 and as the defensive and offensive coordinator in 2011 and 2012, respectively. He also served as the defensive backs coach on the gold-medal winning U.S. U-19 National Team at the IFAF World Championships in 2009.

"First, I want to say how honored and humbled I am to be named the head football coach at Bryant University," Merritt said. "I want to say thank you to President Machtley and Athletic Director Bill Smith for the opportunity to lead the football program at a first-class academic and athletic institution. I'd also like to thank Columbus High School, specifically Br. Kevin Handibode and Dave Pugh for allowing me the opportunity to be a part of the Marist Columbus Community for the past 18 seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to hit the road recruiting and to begin work with these young men to develop a culture of success. It is my number one goal at Bryant University for every young man in our program to Expect to Win!"

Merritt also served as the head coach of the Hamburg Blue Devils in the German Football League. He guided the Blue Devils to a 48-9-1 record (.936), a pair of European Championships, a national championship and three-straight Charity Bowl Championships. Merritt is the franchises all-time leaders in wins and winning percentage.

Bryant will be Merritt's third collegiate coaching stop. He served as the special teams coordinator and defensive backs coach at Thiel College prior to his time at Columbus and spent two years as an assistant coach at Eastern Illinois University in 1993-94.

Merritt was a four-year letterwinner as a free safety and special teams captain at Indiana University from 1988-92. He began his career as a walk-on before earning a full scholarship and competing in three bowl games.

Merritt has three children, Megan, Ryan, and Shannon.

How it happened

- Stony Brook got on the scoreboard first when Synceir Malone intercepted a pass and returned it 22 yards for a TD with 6:58 left in the first.
- The Bulldog defense kept it a seven-point deficit as Robert Brown forced a fumble at the 1-yard line that was recovered by the Black and Gold.
- Bryant would then drive 66 yards and get on the board with a 49-yard field goal from Luke Samperi.
- The drive was aided by a roughing the passer call and a 28-yard reception by senior Alex Rasmussen on third down.
- The Seawolves answered with an 11-play, 73-yard drive to make it 14-3 with 5:13 left in the second. Tyquell Fields put the ball on the 1 with a 13-yard carry and Isaiah White punched it in.
- Stony Brook posted three rushing touchdowns to open a 35-3 lead in the second half.
- Bryant closed the scoring with a nine-play, 72-yard drive midway through the fourth quarter. Junior Kory Curtis connected with Rasmussen for 27 yards to put the ball in SBU territory. Freshman Anthony Frederick then made a tumbling catch at the SBU 4, setting up a Daniel Adeboboye touchdown two plays later.
